Solutions for the protection of soft fruit crops

The importance of both winter protection against cold damage, and also crop forcing, still requires a degree of forward planning to ensure growers have the correct materials, in the correct sizes and quantities, to enable them to protect and manipulate crops as necessary.

Fleece and perforated polythene

Agrovista supplies and stocks a range of fleece widths and thickness to suit all – from 17g/m² to 30g/m² – from 1.6m width up to 16m. Our materials offer strength, durability and reinforced edges for the wider materials.

Often used in combination with fleece, as a top layer, our perforated polythene is 40mu clear material with 500 holes/m² – available in a variety of widths and lengths – rolls of 1000m can be made to order.

Planning is crucial to the availability of these products, as both are imported. Agrovista advises growers to order these materials as soon as possible, once cropping programmes are confirmed.

Our tough, durable rubble sacks are available for delivery on farm in January, along with slug pellets and other post trimming/pre covering crop protection products. Use the opportunity to apply high volume drench applications to reduce over wintering inoculum found in plant debris before covering with fleece and/or polythene.

Ground covers and windbreak

Agrovista ground cover is a long lasting, premium material, carrying a minimum 5 year UV guarantee in the UK, offering weed suppression as well as excellent water permeability to avoid puddling. It is ideal for tunnel leg rows, table tops, propagation areas and glasshouse floors.

10 year UVI treated material is now available for longer terms installations.

Widths range from 1.05m to 5.25m as standards, with other widths available to order.
